September 25th to February 8th

- **Barragán: father of Mexican contemporary architecture**
- **The exhibition showcases unique photographs of his work**

The Consulate General of Mexico in Chicago and its **Mexico Tourism Board Office** are pleased to invite you to the opening of the photographic exhibition of the work of Luis Barragán (1902-1988), father of Mexican contemporary architecture, **September 25th, 6:00 pm at La Llorona Art Gallery**. The exhibition includes photographs of the private collection of the **Museo Casa Luis Barragán** in Mexico City. The curator of the exhibition, Mexican architect and photographer **Alberto Moreno** approaches Barragán's works through a critical eye to cast Barragán as the creator of an innovating fusion of space, nature, texture and color.

Barragán created an “emotional” architecture, as he describes it through light, local foliage and color, dedicated to evoke the most sublime sentiments of peace, intimacy and wonder. His very particular style which reflects the origins of colonial and pre-Hispanic Mexican cultural heritage founded the modernist movement in Mexico.

Barragán was awarded the Pritzker Architecture Prize in 1980.
