Morgan Szymanski who has featured artist on the cover of Classical Guitar Magazine and was a finalist in the '2008 Outstanding Young Artist Award' (MIDEM Classique/IAMA), will for the first time perform at Canning House. The guitarist will present themes from composers such as, Mauro Giuliani, Manuel M. Ponce, Paulo Bellinati and Astor Piazzolla.

Born in Mexico City in 1979, Morgan Szymanski started playing the guitar at the early age of six. Early studies at the National Music School (Mexico) and the Edinburgh Music School led to a scholarship to study under Carlos Bonell and Gary Ryan and the Royal College of Music in London.

He continued his successes at the college by becoming the first guitarist to be ever awarded a Junior Fellowship at the RCM, where he completed his Masters with distinction.

A top prize-winner at international competitions, his performances as a soloist and with orchestras have taken him to concert halls as the Wigmore Hall - where he played duets with John Williams - to all around the world.
